It is an offence to:

- vote using a ballot paper that was not sent for your use or interfere with another voter's ballot paper
- vote more than once at {P 81, Variable 1} {P82, Variable 2}, unless you are voting on your own behalf and as a proxy for another person
- vote as a proxy at {P 81, Variable 1} {P82, Variable 2} for more than two people, unless you are their spouse, civil partner, parent, grandparent, brother, sister, child or grandchild
- vote as a proxy for someone if you know that by law they are not allowed to vote

3. Complete both of these and return them straightaway.
